

Durgin and Crowell Fiber Sourcing Policies

Durgin and Crowell Lumber Co., Inc. (“Durgin and Crowell”) is a Program Participant of the Sustainable Forestry Initiative® (SFI). Durgin and Crowell supports the goals and objectives of SFI, in particular the promotion of sustainable forestry, promotion of certified and licensed woodlot management, conservation of critical wildlife habitats, and the widespread use of Best Management Practices (“BMPs”) by our log suppliers.

The following represent Durgin and Crowell’s policies regarding purchase of wood fiber, for use at its Springfield, NH sawmill and production facility:

1. Durgin and Crowell will not, knowingly, purchase fiber which has been harvested as a result of *illegal logging* (as defined in the 2015-2019 SFI Fiber Sourcing Standard).
2. Durgin and Crowell will cooperate with landowners, enforcement officials, and log suppliers to resolve any questions regarding illegal logging, as related to fiber purchased by Durgin and Crowell.
3. As required by the SFI Standard, Durgin and Crowell has a program to monitor the use of Best Management Practices (BMPs) by its log suppliers.
4. Each active log supplier to Durgin and Crowell must sign and fill out the Durgin and Crowell Log Supplier Procurement Agreement.
5. Durgin and Crowell will have a policy in order to address Mud Season(s) and other inclement weather issues.
6. Durgin and Crowell encourages and supports the use of trained loggers, licensed foresters, and other qualified professionals, as defined in the 2015-2019 SFI Fiber Sourcing Standard.
